


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HS Counseling Goals

School Types



Public Schools

• Local School District - Everyone needs to apply



Charter Schools

• Free, Lottery System, Smaller than many public schools



Parochial Schools

• Tuition based, Affiliated with Archdiocese, Independent from School District



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Independent Schools

- Day School Tuition based, independent from school district
- Boarding Schools 5 or 7 day boarding, Tuition based, independent from school district

Researching Schools

Facts vs. Opinions/Stereotypes

Students AND Parents/Guardians should be researching

- **General**: Class size, Co-ed?, Parochial, Location, Diversity
- Academics: Classes offered, Class style, Grading, Facilities, Schedule
- Values/Feel: Mission alignment, Sense of Community, JEDI
- Co-curricular: Sports, Theater, Arts, Newspaper, Clubs, Leadership

Answer all parts of the questions.


Note important deadlines.

The Process: Today to April 2023



- Sept Dec '22 : Visit Schools/ School Events
- October '22 January '23 : Complete parent and student applications
- Nov Dec '22 : Standardized testing (?) & Teacher Recommendations & Transcripts
- Nov December ' 22: Financial Aid Applications Complete
- Dec-Jan '23 : Application Deadlines
- Feb March '23 : Decisions communicated
- Early Spring '23 : Revisit days / Reply to School Decisions
