We are proud to report that in the 2017-2018 school year:


- Our students met or exceeded 80% of the 1,446
 individualized learning goals we set, spanning literacy,
 writing, numeracy, inquiry and social-emotional learning
 (this is up from 74% last year);*
- 71% of students are at or above grade level in reading**
- 71% of students are at or above grade level in numeracy
- 74% of students are at or above grade level in writing

^{*}Assessments include standards-aligned rubrics for writing, inquiry and SEL and benchmark assessments for numeracy

^{**}Reading levels are calculated using A-Z independent reading levels


Our 3rd grade students outperformed both San Francisco Unified and the State for English Language Arts and Numeracy.*
